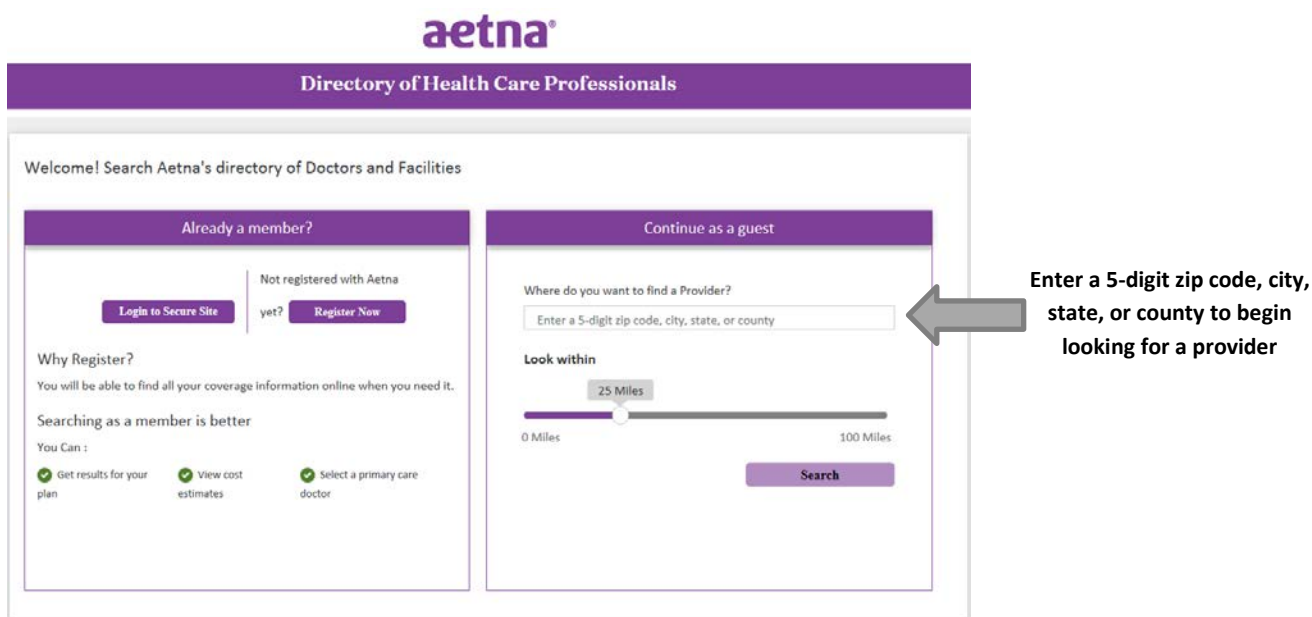


Aetna HMO (Full Network)

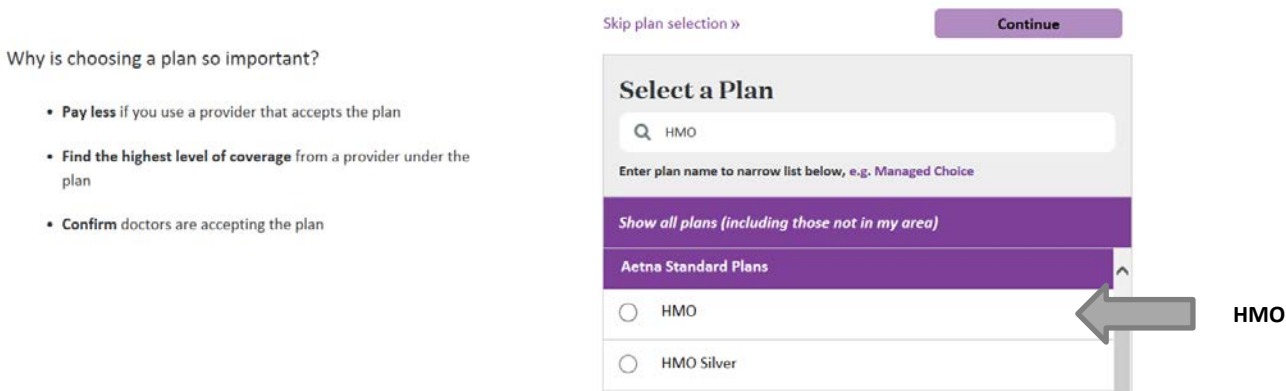
1. Log on to: <http://www.aetna.com>
2. Continue as a guest and enter required fields.

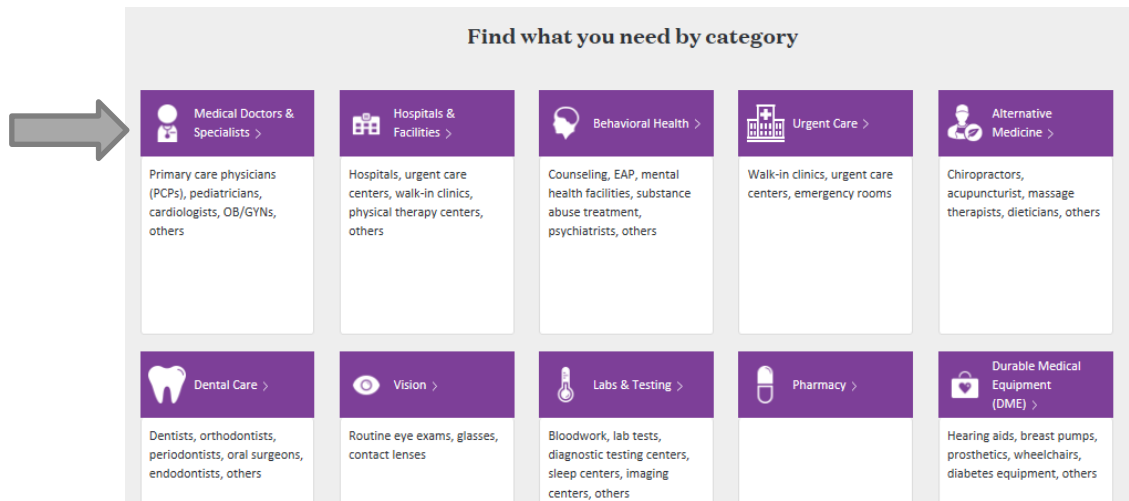
3. Select "Aetna Standard Plans"

If you are an Aetna member, you may find your plan name on your member ID Card or in your Enrollment Documents

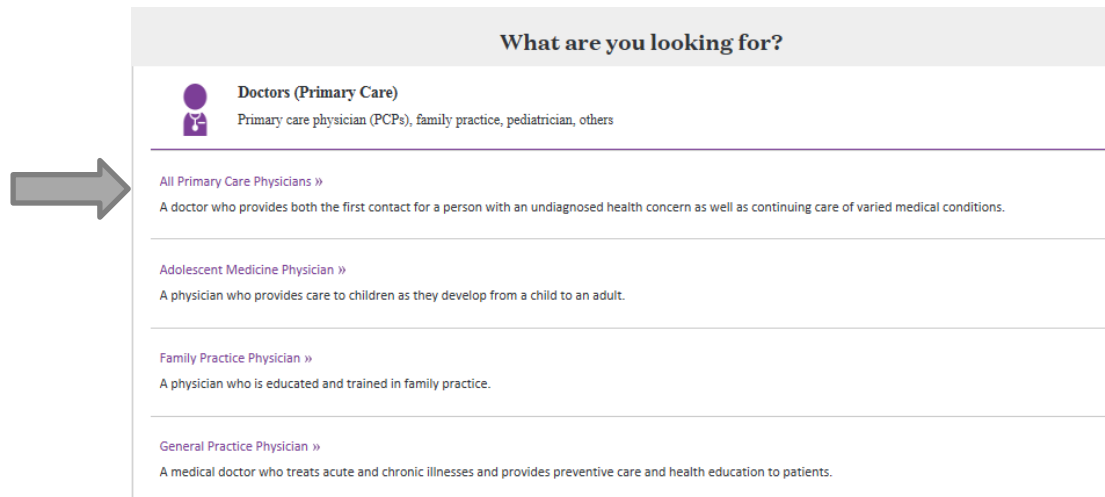
